gnatius L. Smetek started his own money management firm last month, Arcataur Capital Management LLC, Milwaukee. Mr. Smetek was an analyst and portfolio manager at Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Co., Milwaukee, from 1986 until August 2002, when he resigned to spend more time with his family.

Thinking he probably would change careers, Mr. Smetek explored various possibilities but said, "I missed the markets. As bad as they were, I missed managing money."

Mr. Smetek manages an active domestic large-cap core growth strategy and is about to hire an experienced fixed-income portfolio manager with a high credit-quality focus. In addition to managing core bond portfolios, the new manager will handle the fixed-income portion of a balanced strategy for institutional and retail managed in bed and my wife is ready to call it a night, I can go down to my home office and be very productive on all kinds of work-related matters," he said.

Mr. Smetek created the name of his new firm from astronomical sources by blending the names of Arktos, the bear-guard star (the word means "bearish" in Greek), and the constellation Taurus (the Latin word for bull).
